WSCUC Recommendations and Special Visit Preparation (as reported by Dr. Brian Street)

- a. Recommendation 3: *Ensure consistency, effectiveness, and quality of academic support services, including advising, tutoring, supplemental instruction, and course scheduling, to enhance student success for all students. (CFRs 2.12, 2.13)*
The Commission appreciated learning about the launch of the Council for Faculty Advising, additional staff for tutoring and supplemental instruction, and other changes in this area.
