- In general, advisors prefer to advise students at the same time they register them for classes. Transfer students have a lot of pre-requisite errors or they are trying to navigate a system that has a lot of closed classes and try to find alternative options. Advisors have to prepare each students' advising documents ahead so that they are able to advise them.
- We need to push for the degree audit to be accurate.

One of the reasons why advisors have to advise when registration has already opened up is because they have to override a lot. An example from our fall admits, is when a student who was enrolled in the Spring 2020 with B1
