Teaching Credential Candidates must provide verification of Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) training that meets the standard set by the American Red Cross and American Heart Association for **Infant, Child, and Adult** in order to be eligible to apply for their preliminary teaching credential. Verification can be provided by submitting a copy of your signed CPR card or certificate.
