

# CSUB Undergraduate Academic Integrity Policy

## Philosophy on Academic Integrity:

CSUB is committed to the highest standards of academic integrity. We believe that academic integrity is the foundation of a quality education and is essential for the success of our students. We are committed to creating a culture of honesty, integrity, and respect for the academic process. We believe that academic integrity is a shared responsibility of all members of the CSUB community, including students, faculty, and staff. We are committed to providing a fair and equitable process for addressing academic integrity violations and to supporting students who are struggling with academic challenges.

## Policy:

CSUB's Academic Integrity Policy is based on the following principles: (1) All members of the CSUB community are responsible for maintaining the highest standards of academic integrity.
