

**CSUB Title Vb: STEM Graduate Excellence**  
**Graduate student-faculty collaborative research program**  
**Research**  
**Summer 2022**

**Summary**

The Graduate Student-Faculty Collaborative Research program (GCRP) is funded by CSUB Title Vb to support graduate student-faculty teams conducting research during Summer 2022, with required presentations and reports during Summer and Fall 2022. Support is available for graduate student-faculty team from our STEM-associated graduate programs. Graduate students will submit a short research proposal outlining their proposed research/project and faculty mentors will submit a letter outlining their proposed mentoring activities and collaborative

Students are required to present their findings at the Summer SURE Poster Session (Aug. 4, 2022) and at the CSUB Grad Slam (Fall Semester 2022; date TBD). Reports on research progress are due at the end of the Summer session and at the end of the Fall semester.

**Support**

The total award amount to the student is \$1,500. The student stipend will be divided into three disbursements of \$500 upon completion of required milestones, with disbursements occurring:

- 1) at the start of the summer session following submission of signed faculty and student MOUs,
- 2) following participation in the SURE 2022 poster presentation and summer report submission, and
- 3) following participation in the CSUB Grad Slam 2022 and submission of the final report in the Fall semester.

The faculty mentor will receive \$500 at the end of the Fall semester following successful completion of all student mentee activities.

Repeat student participation is permitted and past student GCRP awardees may apply.

**Expectations**

Participants (graduate student-faculty teams) are expected to:

- 1) regularly meet to discuss research activities and progress and these meetings should be documented.
- 2) complete, as much as possible, their proposed research and activities.
- 3) complete requested assessment and reporting activities.
- 4) be a collaborative member of the graduate student-faculty research team, committed to inclusive graduate student mentoring

Faculty mentors are expected to:

- 1) complete all requested assessment and reporting activities.
- 2) encourage the student mentee to disseminate the results of their research at meetings,
