A meeting invitation can be generated by logginnto Zoom from the client, or directly from BlackBoard

If using the website or the client simply copy he invitation information and email ito your students. The invitation will contain a link that your student can click and the lirectly to the Zoom meeting.

If usingBlackBoard a Zoom meetingnvitation can be easily creted by navigating to the Content section of your course You will find the Zoom Meeting mode under the Tools > More ToolsZoom Meeting This will add a content module that youstudent can click and take the directly to the Zoonsession.
