Our programs prepare candidates to teach students with disabilities in a mild/moderate or extensive support needs in a K-12 classroom. Our teacher candidates are provided the tools to create diverse, equitable, and supportive learning environments with an integrative approach to theory and practice.

The program is about 50 semester units and an added authorization for early childhood is available for 9 additional units. Program courses begin in the early evenings and are held in a variety of formats.

Step 1 - Apply to the university

Apply as a graduate student at: calstate.edu/apply/graduate Requirements:

2.5 GPA or higher required

Good academic standing from previous university

Meet professional, personal, scholastic, and other standards for graduate study

Step 2 – Enroll in prerequisites
